

## Results of General Election Manual Audit

On Monday, November 17, 2008, the Citrus County Canvassing Board conducted a manual audit of election equipment in compliance with the Florida audit law. The audit law requires the canvassing board select one race at random to be manually audited in 2% of the precincts also randomly selected.

The random selection of the race to be audited was the Fifth District Court of Appeal Retention of Judge C. Alan Lawson in precinct 109.

The ballots from the Election Day voting precinct were manually recounted as well as the early votes, absentees domestic and overseas and provisional ballots.
